\* In 1941, Mucio R. Delgado, program manager with the Prescott radio station KYTA, met Nelson Rockefeller, Assistant Secretary of State for Latin American Affairs, at a meeting of the Inter-American Affairs in San Francisco. At that time, Jimmy Creasman was Delgado's counterpart and friend. In this interview in 1945, Delgado was a representative of the IAA in New York and no longer lived in Arizona. Because of his work as a representative for the IAA, he was probably familiar with FDR's Good Neighbor Policy and his intent to foster better relations with our allies in Latin America and Mexico. Delgado's work was important, made clear in this short interview with Pyle. (Christine Marin)
