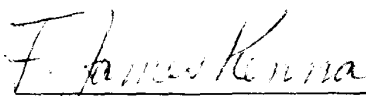
We have reviewed your January 12, 2000 request to amend the referenced Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the list of projects attached to your letter and the Pima Association of Governments (PAG) Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for FY 2000 through 2002. The PAG TIP was approved by the PAG Regional Council on September 22, 1999. This action will also include FY 2002 for the Maricopa Association of Governments (MAG) TIP which was approved by the MAG Regional Council on June 9, 1999. FY 2000 and FY 2001 of the MAG TIP was approved by STIP Amendment No. 12 dated September 28, 1999. A copy of your letter requesting this amendment is enclosed.

We accept this Amendment in accordance with 23 CFR 450 and find that this STIP amendment was developed based on a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive transportation planning process in accordance with the 23 USC and Section 5303 of the Federal Transit Act (49 USC 53.) A finding of conformity was made for the PAG TIP (2000-2004) on October 13, 1999 and for the MAG TIP (2000-2004) on June 9, 1999. Additional projects in this amendment are exempt from conformity determinations.

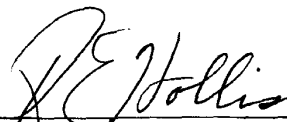
