## INDIVIDUAL INCOME TAX CREDIT FOR DONATIONS TO PRIVATE SCHOOL TUITION ORGANIZATIONS: REPORTING FOR 2004 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- \$31,871,900 in donations to private school tuition organizations was reported to the Arizona Department of Revenue for 2004. This is an increase of 8.2% over the \$29,445,494 reported for 2003.
- 63,830 donations to private school tuition organizations were reported, an increase of 9.8% over 2003.
- The Department was aware of 55 school tuition organizations operating in Arizona in 2004, an increase from 51 in 2003. Of these 55 organizations, 53 submitted the statutorily-required report.
- Although the majority of donors to school tuition organizations are taxpayers filing with a married filing joint filing status who can claim a credit of up to \$625, the average donation in 2004 was \$499, down from \$507 in 2003.
- Scholarships paid by school tuition organizations in 2004 totaled \$28.2 million, a 15% increase over the amount of scholarships paid in 2003.
- The number of scholarships paid in 2004 was 21,160, a 5.1% increase over the 20,138 scholarships paid in 2003.
- 334 private schools in Arizona received scholarship money from school tuition organizations.
- 3 school tuition organizations gave scholarships to only one private school.
- 6 school tuition organizations gave scholarships to 25 or more private schools.
- The smallest average scholarship paid by a school tuition organization was \$28, paid by Chaparral Mission Scholarship Fund to Navajo Trails in Winslow.
- The largest average scholarship paid by a school tuition organization was \$12,376, paid by New Way Learning Academy School Tuition Organization to New Way Learning Academy.
- The majority of the scholarships and the scholarship money was paid in Maricopa County.

## **INDIVIDUAL INCOME TAX CREDIT FOR DONATIONS TO PRIVATE SCHOOL TUITION ORGANIZATIONS: REPORTING FOR 2004**

Arizona's individual income tax credit for contributions to school tuition organizations, more commonly referred to as the private school tax credit, is governed by A.R.S. §43-1089. School tuition organizations (STOs) must report the following information to the Arizona Department of Revenue by February 28:

1. The name, address and contact name of the STO.
2. The number of contributions received in the previous calendar year.
3. The dollar amount of contributions received in the previous calendar year.
4. The number of children awarded scholarships or grants during the previous calendar year.
5. The dollar amount of scholarships and grants awarded during the previous calendar year.
6. The name and address of each school receiving the scholarships or grant money, along with the number and dollar amount of scholarships or grants provided to each school.

The Arizona Department of Revenue is aware of 55 STOs operating in Arizona in 2004, up from 51 in 2003. Two STOs<sup>1</sup> have failed to provide any information. These STOs have been contacted by telephone and/or letter requesting the required information. (There is no penalty in statute for failure to report.) Neither has indicated that the information required is forthcoming.

For those STOs that have reported, the number and amount of donations are set out in the following table. For calendar year 2004, \$31.9 million has been reported by 53 STOs, an 8.2% increase over the donations reported for 2003. The largest STO, the Catholic Tuition Organization for the Diocese of Phoenix, reported \$7.5 million in donations, 24% of the total. STOs reported \$28.2 million in scholarships paid to 21,160 students in 2004, an average of \$1,334 per scholarship. This is a 15% increase in total scholarships reported over calendar year 2003 and a 9.4% increase in the average scholarship. The following table shows the history of scholarships and grants paid out by STOs, based on information reported to the Department of Revenue. (In prior years, some STOs reported donations received but did not report scholarships paid out.) Average scholarship as shown in the table is calculated *only* for those STOs that reported *both* the number and amount of scholarships paid. (STOs that reported no scholarships paid out were not included in the count or in the averages.) The range of average scholarship amounts is from \$280 (Dynamite Montessori Foundation) to \$12,376 (New Way Learning Academy School Tuition Organization). STOs provided scholarships and grants to 334 private schools throughout Arizona. Arizona School Choice Trust provided scholarships and grants to 132 schools, more schools than any other STO. Appendix III, at the end of this report, lists the number of schools to which each STO provided scholarships. That information is aggregated in the following table.

As shown above, three STOs gave scholarships to only one private school. Those three STOs are Educare Scholarship Fund, New Way Learning Academy School Tuition Organization and Patagonia Scholarship Fund.

One private school received scholarship/grant money from as many as nine different STOs. This private school was Northwest Christian School in Phoenix, receiving 650 scholarships for \$843,100. The following table shows the number of STOs contributing scholarship/grant money to the private schools.

In other words, 160 private schools received scholarship/grant money from only one STO. There were 75 private schools that received scholarship/grant money from two STOs.

The *smallest* average scholarship paid by an STO to one private school was \$28 paid by Chaparral Mission Scholarship Fund to Navajo Trails in Winslow. The *highest* average scholarship paid by an STO to one private school was \$12,376 paid by New Way Learning Academy School Tuition Organization to New Way Learning Academy.

The most scholarship/grant money received by one private school was \$843,100 for 650 scholarships to Northwest Christian School in Phoenix. The scholarship/grant money came from nine different STOs, for an average of \$1,297. Appendix IV lists the 334 private schools that received scholarship/grant money, the number of scholarships, the amount and the average scholarship. This table also shows the percent change in amount of scholarship money received and the percent change in the average scholarship paid if the private school was reported as receiving scholarship money in 2003.

In terms of where the scholarship/grant money went within Arizona, the most money went to schools within the city of Phoenix. Slightly more than 31% of the scholarships went to 81 private schools in Phoenix and about 37% of the money. As would be expected, 65% of all scholarships granted were in Maricopa County and 69% of the money. These are the same percentages as in 2003. Appendix V shows the cities within which the scholarship/grant money was received, the average scholarship and the percent change from 2003.
