





1)	The original 1899 Arizona Territorial Football League Championship Cup shall henceforth be known and
	referred to in all media as the "Territorial Cup". (TC) A replica of the original cup has been manufactured
	and will be known and referred to in all media as the "Territorial Cup Replica" (TCR).

- 2) The TC has been and will continue to be the property of Arizona State University (ASU), Property Control Number ______. ASU loans this cup to the University of Arizona in accordance with all the terms of this protocol.
- 4) The ASU contact person for all questions relating to the TC or the TCR shall be the University Archivist, ASU Libraries, Box 871006, Tempe, AZ 85287-1006. 480.965.3145 This individual will take full responsibility for ensuring the security and preservation of the TC or TCR while in the possession of ASU.
- 5) The University of Arizona (UA) contact person for all questions relating to the TC or TCR shall be the Special Collections Team Leader, University of Arizona Library, 1510 E. University, Tucson, Arizona 85721 520-621-6433 (phone) 520-621-9733 This individual will take full responsibility for ensuring the security and preservation of the TC or TCR while in the possession of UA.
- 6) Each year the TC and the TCR will be awarded to the winner of the ASU/UA football game for the purpose of public display. In case of a tie game, the TC and the TCR will be displayed at ASU.
- 7) ASU and UA will provide a publicly accessible display case and intercampus transportation that meets archival requirements for security and preservation to be established by the ASU and UA contacts listed in protocols 4 and 5. The display will include appropriate captioning that distinguishes the TC from the TCR.
- 8) The TC shall **only** be used for public display in the cases described in protocol 7 above. The TCR shall be used for all on and off field activities, ceremonies, events and other displays. ASU and UA shall entertain requests to borrow the TCR for events of their respective institutions.
- 9) The TC should **always** be handled with white cotton gloves and should **never** be cleaned. The TCR may be handled with gloves to preserve the finish and may be cleaned as needed using an appropriate silver cleaner or polish.
