

# Using Proximity Operators

Proximity operators are used to specify the relationship between terms in a search. They are used to find terms that are adjacent to each other in a document. The most common proximity operators are WITHIN, WITH, and NOT WITHIN. The character n stands for a number, for example, WITHIN 50 would find terms that are within 50 characters of each other.

The WITH operator specifies that the first term must precede the second term. For example, WITH 10 would find terms that are within 10 characters of each other, with the first term preceding the second term.

NOT WITHIN specifies that the first term must not precede the second term. For example, NOT WITHIN 10 would find terms that are within 10 characters of each other, but the first term does not precede the second term.

The WITHIN operator specifies that the first search term must precede the second term by exactly n words. For example, WITHIN 5 would find terms that are exactly 5 words apart. The WITH operator specifies that the first search term must precede the second term by at most n words. For example, WITH 5 would find terms that are at most 5 words apart.

NOT WITHIN specifies that the first search term must not precede the second term by at most n words. For example, NOT WITHIN 5 would find terms that are not within 5 words of each other.

ACT/INFORM Order: This operator accounts for the relative positions of the two terms in a search. For example, ACT/INFORM 10 would find terms that are within 10 characters of each other, with the first term preceding the second term. The system interprets the expression ACT/INFORM 10 as WITHIN 10 AND WITH 10.

Using Proximity Operators: This section provides examples of how to use proximity operators in a search. For example, WITHIN 50 AND WITH 10 would find terms that are within 50 characters of each other and within 10 characters of each other, with the first term preceding the second term.
