Established through legislative action in 1984, Arizona State University West Campus serves close to 3,500 junior, senior and graduate students each semester in northwestern Maricopa County.

Students choose from more than 400 classes in the areas of arts and sciences, business, education, engineering, nursing, public programs and social work.

The Sands Classroom Building, completed in January 1989, houses close to two-thirds of all West Campus classes for the spring term. Other classes continue to be held at temporary sites.

When construction on the 300-acre campus at 4701 West Thunderbird Road is completed, Arizona State University West will be a major institution serving approximately 20,000 students.
