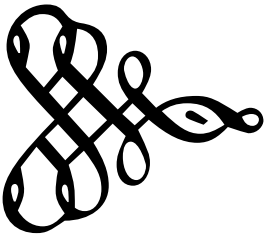

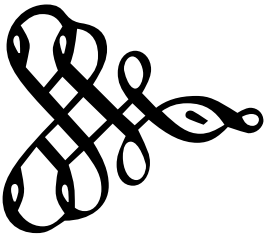

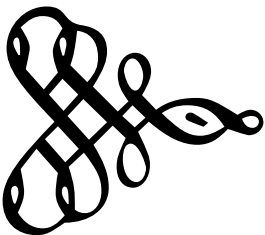
In turn

to build the prose of this introduction.

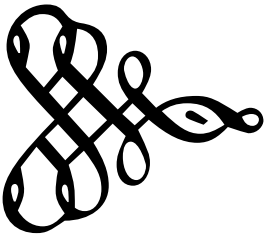
In the area of poetry

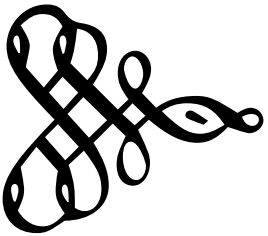

believes it is better to punish everyone.

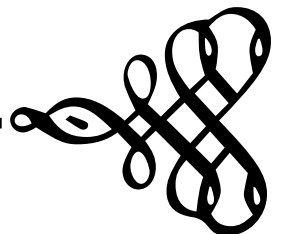
Sometimes I just prefer rumours;

can be learned.

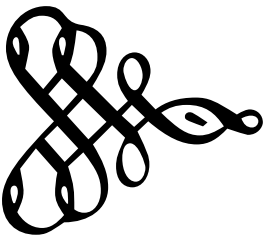

supposes that deforming it is enough.

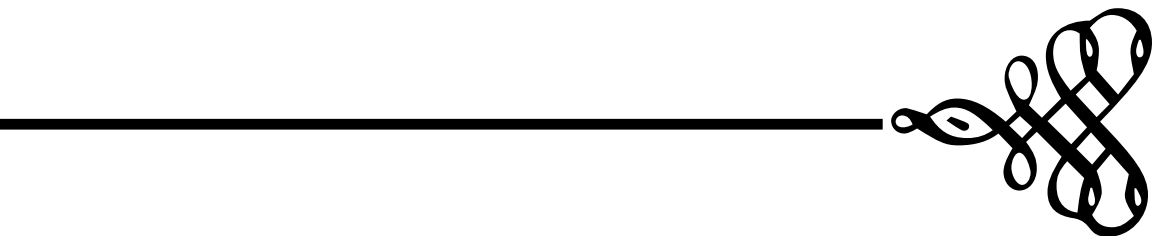
The populist leader,

is to transform a process in unnecessary and irrelevant.

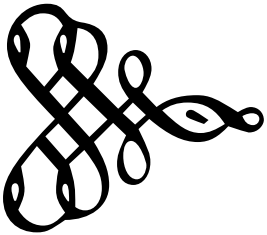
An essential part of maturing
