He was a quiet, industrious citizen, elway: ready to extend a belping hand to an unfortunate citizen. He was a native of Virginia and was about 77 years of age. His funeral occurred at willians on Tuesday.

Secember 25, 1869 - Sam Ball, of vickenburg, was in tom this week, and talked some of joining the party that is to leave hore soon, to prospect the region north of Prescott. Should be do so, be will join the party at llardyville. Sam is a good mountaineers, and the party would like very much to have him along.

March 26, 1870,- -The last of the Richardson proapeeting party got in Tuesday last. The party gave the region bounded by the Bif and Iittle Colorado rivers, and the Sen Francicco range of mounted ns, a pretty thorough exploration, and failod to find paying disgins. They ady the country consists of high, level mappy many of which are coverved with a danae growth of timber, and $2 l l$ alothod with grass. Messrs. Richardson and Ball assure us that it is a dolightiol country. The northernmost route of the 35th parallel railroed passes through it, and all the men agree that it is an exoedlent one.
