My dear Lou:

A newspaper man told me, this morning, that Senator Cameron had called at the Department of Justice within the last few days to protest against the activity of the Attorney General in prosecuting the suits that were filed against the locators of mining claims within the Grand Canyon National Park. He said the Senator and Attorney General Stone had a very heated discussion of the subject, but did not know much more than that about what actually occurred.
