The writer has been working upon your suggestion relative to the County disposing of the Bright Angel Trail, and believe an agreement can be reached whereby the County will sell its interest to the Government, provided a sufficient amount is appropriated, which amount the county will agree to spend upon the road from Maine to the Canyon.

Since you were here, I have talked with the Supervisors, both the old members and new ones, and I feel confident if the matter can be taken up with the Appropriations Committee the deal can be consummated. When you have an opportunity will you kindly ascertain if the Committee would consider such a proposition?

Mr. Smith, Assistant Supt of the Park informed the writer that an appropriation had been made some three or four years ago, to build a road leading from Cody, Wyoming to the entrance to the Park there, so with that precedent perhaps you might get a straight appropriation to apply upon the road, from the Park boundary south.

Will be glad to hear from you after you receive any information upon the above subjects.
