Dear Sir :--

Referring to the Forester's letters to me of November 1, 1909 and December 4, 1909 and to the verbal instructions given me by the Forester and the Chief of the office of Occupancy in the matter of the definite location of a railroad from Grand Canyon Station to the hotel and mines of the Canyon Copper Company:

This matter has been somewhat delayed by the unsettled financial conditions and by the continued unfavorable copper market situation.

However we now expect to make the survey of definite location in the near future and desire that the proper local forest official shall be advised and instructed by you to supervise the selection of the location so
