# **Unemployment in Arizona:**

In real numbers, rather than percentages, it is expected that the number of unemployed Arizonans, 25 and older, will rise from around 400,000 in 2010 to nearly 700,000 by 2030.







## Arizona's Personal Income:

Average individual incomes in Arizona flattened out through most of the 2000s and began declining in 2009.

# **Arizona's Poverty Rate:**

In 2010 approximately **1.2 million** Arizonans lived below the federally defined poverty level.

By 2030 that number is expected to rise to around **1.9 million**.







- 64% of the respondents think we don't spend enough on our public school system overall.
- 50% believe we should spend more on Kindergarten-middle school.







**52%** believe AZ public schools don't prepare students to pursue specific career paths.







69% of Arizonans believe it is critical to increase trade with Mexico.







70% would like to see more moderate candidates run for office.
